Job and assignments

Crane operators are experts at operating lifting and hoisting devices. They perform loading/unloading of cargoes on ships (platform or lay barges). They check slings, shackles and crane boom cables, factoring in weights and applicable limits. Offshore crane operators may also have to perform minor servicing operations on lifting equipment.

Work environment

Platforms, port areas and ships are where they operate, in France and abroad. Their duty include day and night work, sometimes in poor weather conditions during offshore operations. It is necessary to be fit and wear PPEs.

CAP-BEP	▶ CAP/BEP Public works equipment operator
Certificates	▶ CACES (to certify your ability to operate safely) ▶ Crane Operator training certificate, licensed by the National Committee for the Certification of Crane Operators (NCCCO) ▶ BOSIET/HUET are compulsory (emergency trainings)
BAC	▶ Maintenance of equipments (majoring in public works and lifting/hoisting)
